Botanical name: Zingiber officinale Roxb.

Family: Zingiberaceae

Common name: Ginger

Description- An erect, slender and herbaceous plant, Z. officinale can grow up to 1.8 m high. Shoots (pseudostems) extend above ground, arising from buds on the underground rhizomes, which are thickened, branched, somewhat resembling a swollen hand.
