Plumbago zeylanica

Common name:

White leadwort

Description:

Chitraka consists of dried mature root of Plumbagozeylanica Linn. (Fam.Plumbaginaceae), a large perennial sub-scandent shrub, found throughout India in wile State and

occasionally cultivated in gardens.

Attributes-

Rasa-Katu, Vipaka-Katu, Veerya-Ushana, Guna-Tikshna, laghu, Ruksha.

Chitraka is used in treating intestinal troubles, dysentery, leucoderma, Medicinal uses: inflammation, piles, bronchitis, itching, diseases of the liver, and consumption. The leaves of this herb work well for treating laryngitis, rheumatism, diseases of the spleen, ring worm, scabies, and it acts as an aphrodisiac. A tincture of the root bark is used as an anti-periodic. Chitrak root helps improve digestion and it stimulates the appetite. Chitrak root is also an acro-narcotic poison that can cause an abortion.
