## **TABEBUIA**

Marathi: Halka Gulabi Tabubia

Botanical name: Tabebuia rosea
Synonyms: Tabebuia rosea
Family: Bignoniaceae

Common name: Pink trumpet tree, Pink tecoma, Rosy trumpet treeative to continental

America

Description: Pink trumpet is a tall, fast-growing tree reaching 25 to 30 m high and 1 m

d.b.h. The crown is wide, stratified, and irregular, with a few thick, horizontal branches; the bole is straight, sometimes channeled at base. Leaves are palmately divided into 5 unequal leaflets. The oval/oblong leaflets have a rough-to-touch surface, entire margin and a pointed tapering tip. The central leaflet is larger than the rest. The leaflet size is variable between 3-18 inches. Flowering occurs between December and February, when the tree bursts into panicles of pink trumpet shaped flowers with yellow throats.

Attributes: Rasa-.... Vipaka-.... Veerya-..... Guna-.....

Medicinal uses: A decoction of the flowers, leaves and roots has been used to reduce fevers and pain, cause sweating, to treat tonsil inflammation and various other disorders.
